


THE CALL




Dear Church Family,





QUILT OF VALOR



Dale Gregory joined the Navy in 1986 and went through basic training in January and February at Great Lakes. After finishing basic training, he went across the street and attended hospital corpsman school. From there, he attended basic medical laboratory school in Fort Sam Houston, Texas. He finished his active-duty tour in California at Fort Ord working in a triservice blood bank (Army, Navy, and Air Force). For a short time, Dale served as an active reservist. While fulfilling his reserve duty, his unit

was activated and sent to Bahrain for Operations Desert Shield and Desert Storm. The quality of his service earned him an expert pistol medal, the National Defense Medal, the Kuwait Liberation Medal, and the Southwest Asian Service Medal with 1 Bronze Star. HIs final discharge was in March 1991.

We are proud to call Dale Gregory a member of our community and our family. The Fellowship Quilters would like to present him with this Quilt of Honor in acknowledgement not only of his military service, but also in acknowledgement of his service to God and country in the 30 years since his discharge.
