

Last month was the beginning of Lent, that season when we prepare our hearts and minds for receiving Jesus' transforming work in our lives as well as the life of the church. In the coming weeks on Wednesdays at 6:00 PM in the Fellowship Hall, the Elders are having a soup meal with a Lenten Devotion. It was be around an hour with the food, fellowship and devotion. This year makes our church's 103rd year Birthday. To celebrate we are doing a "Faith Promise with a Purpose" to raise money to re-carpet the sanctuary, offices and hallways. It is a joy and an honor to serve as one of thirteen pastors in this over a century of ministry to our friends and neighbors in the Casper area. May God in His infinite wisdom and glory give us many more years together as we work on our vision of changing lives through Christ as we welcome, equip and share Jesus to those in our lives. Making lunches on Saturday - 1st - FCC


2nd - FCC and Sovereign Grace Church (every other month) 3rd - LDS Church 4th - FCC
