

FALL BACK AN HOUR ON

SUNDAY, NOV. 3, 2024



#### Dear Church Family,

This month we remember those who have passed at the end of 2023 and so far in 2024. In our All Saint's Sunday Service Teresa shared with us a song that touches her heart and shared how it can give us a sense of calm in the storm of grief. This past month Teresa and I watched a movie called: Unsung Hero. If you haven't seen it, I highly recommend it. It is the journey of faith of a family who moved from Australia to Nashville, Tennessee. It is the life journey of Christian artists Rebecca St. James and her brothers and sisters as well as her parents. Rebecca's younger brothers formed a Christian group called: King + Country. The reason I bring this up is that grief is and continues to be a big part of our lives. We grieve for those loved ones who have passed away, we grieve for the lives we envision but have not realized, we grieve for things we have done and those things that are yet to be, we GRIEVE. But in our grief can we find hope and a reason to push on? That is the in many ways the thesis of this movie - HOPE.

Over the past several days I have attended classes that are a requirement for my standing in the Christian Church, Disciples of Christ in the Central Rocky Mountain Region. One was Anti-racism and pro-reconciliation and the other was Boundary training. I do not agree with some of the things that were taught in these classes, yet I learned that reconciliation is key to most of life. The ability to offer grace and forgiveness is paramount to our faith and even though we may not agree with everyone, we must extend the hand of grace to others. In this political season it may surprise you that I agree with both candidates for president: This is a most critical time in our democracy! It is critical because we must extend an open hand of grace across political, emotional and spiritual divides and remember that Jesus is Lord. If we put all things at Jesus' and rest in His humility and grace, we will be his humble servants.

As we gather as church family on November 24th at around 11:30 am and eat our Thanksgiving meal, may we be humbled by the mercy and grace of Jesus and keep open hands and hearts towards others and towards ourselves. Blessings to each and everyone of you and see you Sunday!




#### ANNUAL THANKSGIVING POTLUCK


